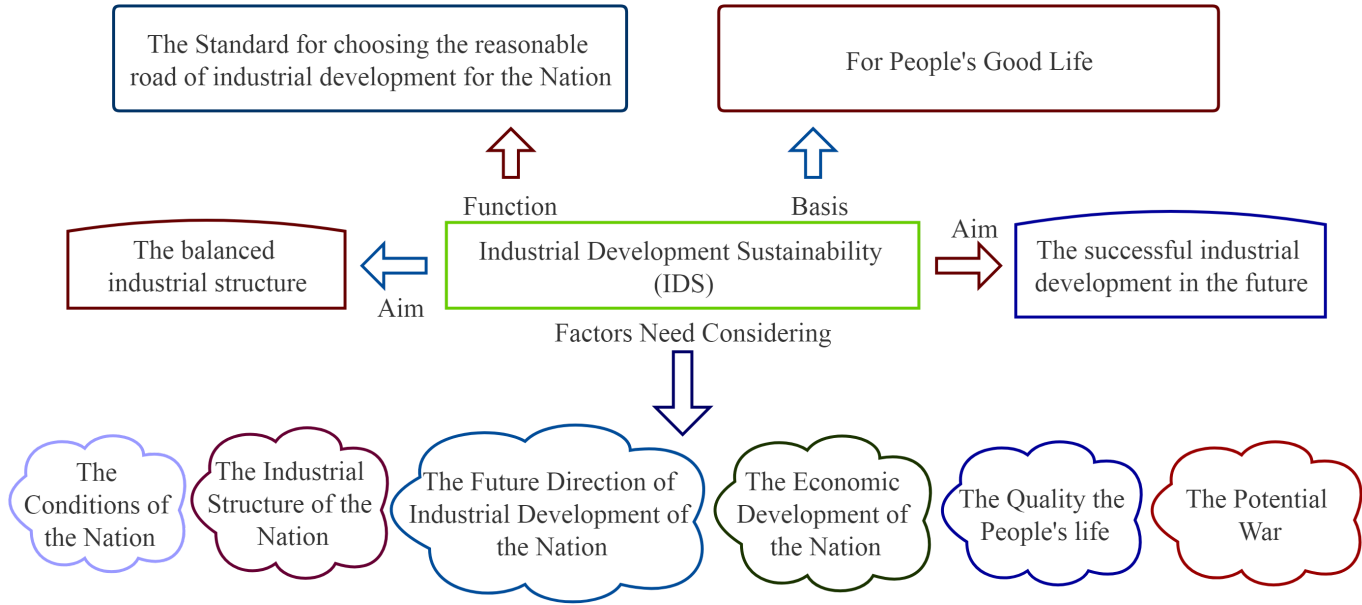

The Industrial Structure of the Nation. 3. The Future Direction of Industrial Development of the Nation. 4. The Economic Development of the Nation. 5. The Quality the People's life. 6. The Potential War.**
